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INTRODUCTION TO THE COVID-19 PREVENTION PROTOCOL

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 3Tre AUDI FIS Ski World Cup in Madonna di Campiglio (Italy) on 22.12.2021 must be held under increased security measures.

Due to the current national and local regulations, according to FIS prevention measures and Organizing Committee dispositions (LOC) we hereby send the protocol of instructions to be taken by the Teams at Madonna di Campiglio event the next 22.12.2021.

This action is part of a wider project of Prevention and Safety against COVID 19 Risk (available on the event website www.3trecampiglio.it), adopted by the LOC, in partnership with local authorities to protect workers health and the entire community as well.

We kindly ask you to forward this protocol to all team members (athletes, coaches, service people, NSA officials etc.) who are registered via the FIS platform.

By registering for this event, each team member entirely confirms and accepts the contents of this protocol of measures for the above mentioned event in full and undertakes to respect it for the good and the health of the community.

This protocol is composed by general and specific measures of prevention mentioned below, covering behavioural and organizing requirements, both collective and individual.

According to the following suggestions, it is recommended to each Team to independently ensure that specific containment measures for COVID 19 risk are developed.













GENERAL PREVENTIVE MEASURES

1. Distance and Protection

It is mandatory to maintain in every situation and condition interpersonal safety distance of at least 1 meter (social distancing) and to wear Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE) in all indoor areas, except for private living quarters, and in all outdoor places, apart from all the specific situations for which is possible to guarantee a continuous condition of isolation.

For those who are carrying out sports activities this obligation may be waived (see below).

Anyway it is strongly recommended to use the Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE) also inside the private living quarters (e.g. Hotel rooms) in case of presence of not permanently cohabitant people.

The mandatory and only usable respiratory IPE are:

- Chirurgical mask
- FFP2 mask
- FFP3 mask

"Community masks" (disposable masks or washable ones, even if self made) are not allowed. Therefore, unless otherwise specified, it's mandatory to always wear a protection to mouth and nose (face mask) on the entire location of the event, except:

- inside the private living quarters (e.g. Hotel rooms);
- during mealtimes;
- during the practice of sport: pre-race activity on/off the track and race activity 1st and 2nd run;
- exclusively the athletes involved on the warm up zone and the starting area (according to social distancing precaution)

2. Sanification

The use of the Individual respiratory Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE) is reinforced with the other measures of control of the infection as the constant and careful hand hygiene and the disinfection of equipment and materials.

3. Rules of Conduct

It is recommended, to move from your accommodation strictly for purposes relating the event activities, taking care, wherever possible, to avoid gatherings.

So, please, spend your free time only with your team members, in small groups.

Minimise your activities to the necessary purchases and the urgent tasks.













4. Avoid gatherings

It is mandatory for all the public places, cabins ski lift and adjacent access spaces included, to expose at the entrance signboards with the requirements about the maximum number of people simultaneously allowed.

Each one of us has to observe this maximum number of people allowed in.

We recommend a good and previous organization to avoid a delay on the fixed time because of a long wait.

The "Green Pass" (a digital or printable proof of vaccination, negative Covid-19 test or recovery from Covid-19) is mandatory to access all areas of the event and other specific places (inside public restaurants, lifts)

To reduce at the minimum the risk of infection, the LOC advise to all the teams the following:

- Remain in small groups;
- Avoid other teams contact;
- Avoid LOC staff contact:
- Avoid tourist and fans contact;
- Journalists interview only at distance and with Individual respiratory
 Protection Equipment (respiratory IPE);
- Wash and sanitize properly and periodically your hands;
- Have a documentation of your current state of health













SPECIFIC PREVENTIVE MEASURES

Racing in Italy and Travel Restriction

Nowadays, in Italy, sport events and competitions organized by National and International Sports Agencies are allowed with limited presence of audience.

The athlete workout sessions are granted according to Federation protocols and observing the requirement about social distancing of at least 1 meter.

In case of athletes, coaches, judges and race stewards or companions arriving from foreing countries there are currently active the ministerial exemptions that are mentioned on this page:

- In case of COVID-19 symptoms do not travel to the venue.
- Avoid stops between the departure point and the event location.
- Avoid contact with other people especially outside the team.

EVENT REGISTRATION

Entries will only be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules for the Alpine Ski World Cups. Entries only will be accepted via the FIS online registration system within the mentioned deadlines. The World Cup rules are available on the FIS website.

Final entry deadline: Tuesday December 15th 2021.

3TRE PREVENTION PLAN CONCEPT

Following the updated FIS Prevention and Mitigation Guidelines, the core elements to guarantee a good level of safety shall be creating different "bubbles" whereby groups who are being regularly tested and disciplined to follow rules and regulations shall be limited to interact with persons not being subject to strict protocols.

3TRE Bubbles System and specific accreditation requirements

RED GROUP/BUBBLE

Athletes, Coaches, Team Support Staff, Equipment Service, SRS, FIS, Timing & Data Negative PCR done before arrival in Madonna di Campiglio (result of PCR to be uploaded on FIS Passport) + GREEN PASS

BLUE GROUP/BUBBLE

Media (Broadcasters, Photographers, Journalists) Local Organising Committee, Officials, Suppliers, Personnel, Workforce, Volunteers

GREEN PASS

*only Media with direct contact with Red Bubble: negative PCR done before arrival in Madonna di Campiglio (negative result to be uploaded on FIS Passport) + GREEN PASS

GREEN GROUP/BUBBLE

Audience, Guests, VIP, Authorities

GREEN PASS

For each group specific prevention measures are envisaged relating to the various operational activities. There are also operational locations and differentiated flows that limit the interaction between the different bubbles.

The following information collected in the document will provide the necessary informations for the individual groups (RED bubbles) in order to describe all the specific measures and useful informations.













3TRE TEAM INFORMATION FOR TEST AND TEST PROTOCOL

People from Red Bubble (team member officially named by the respective National Ski Federation) and people from Blue Bubble (in direct contact with Red Bubble), who wish to access the Event must have and present a negative Covid-19 PCR Test carried out prior to arrival to Madonna di Campiglio. The negative PCR test must be not older than max. 72 hours (max. 72h between taking the sample/smear and collecting the accreditation).

The test result must be uploaded at least 12 hours before arrival on the FIS PASSPORT platform.

Who will arrive from Alta Badia event will have the possibility to undergo a PCR test in Alta Badia on Sunday, December19th before the transfer to Madonna di Campiglio.

REPORTING OF SICKNESS DURING THE EVENT

A C19 Test and Health Center will be operating in Madonna di Campiglio at all times during the event to monitor eventual symptomatic cases and perform rapid antigenic tests if this should be the case.

The 3Tre C19 Test and Health Center will be located in the temporary structure health assessment stands (COVID - 19 station) placed in Madonna di Campiglio in front of 3Tre Headquarter

A positive result will determine exclusion from the race and withdrawal of accreditation.

Who test positive will not be allowed to take part to the event and the specific procedure for C-19 positive case will follow.

COVID-19 Communication

- In case of symptoms immediately inform the LOC at the 3Tre C19 Test and Health Center
- LOC activates the COVID-19 rescue chain
- All communication regarding COVID-19 must be coordinated with FIS and the LOC

LOC COVID 19 OFFICE

Due to the current situation, the LOC must limit the number of accredited persons, we remind all the stakeholders to limit the accreditation requests to the necessary number of people who are really involved during the World Cup Race.

Each team member officially nominated by the respective National Ski Federation should register on the FIS PASSPORT Platform and upload the PCR test before arrival at the event.

In addition to this, the accreditation system of the LOC, Eventbuilder will be the operating platform that will activate all the necessary steps aimed at validating the request and issuing the accreditation (data collection, test verification by the assigned doctor, collection of medical questionnaires)

Only at the end of the Eventbuilder application process the applicant can pick up the accreditation and occupy the reserved rooms of the hotel. For any need, the reference email accreditation@3trecampiglio.it

Only the team captain or a team representative may collect all the accreditations of his Team. Please note that specific protection measures have been adopted on the event site to protect the employees of the LOC and every other people, requirements that must also be observed by the teams when they approach the staff; these provisions are contained in the COVID 19 risk prevention / protection system adopted by the LOC and available on the website.

According to the FIS World Cup rules we will be offering accommodation from the official arrival day until the official departure day. Teams must announce the room reservation via the FIS online registration system.

Please note that accommodation at the FIS rate is available for the official dates of the program only:

Arrival: Monday, 20th December Departure: Thursday , 23rd December

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS rate. Additional Officials have to paid directly the CHF 120,- per night in the hotel. Any extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves.

- The hotels are currently reserved only for athletes and officials according to the FIS quota for the period of the official arrival until the official departure
- Should team members arrive early or leave later, please inform the LOC
 immediately at the following e-mail address: accommodation3tre@campigliodolomiti.it
- Each team member is obliged to stay in the accommodation allocated by the LOC for the duration of the event.
- Wear a respiratory IPE in all public areas.
- In the buffet area a respiratory IPE is compulsory, it can be taken off at the table.
- Further hygiene measures according to the hotels policy.
- Check-in of all team members by the team captain.
- Maintain social distancing in all areas.

TC MEETING

The Team Captains Meeting is scheduled at 17:00 on 21st December 2021 at PalaCampiglio. Access is guaranteed to a limited number of people in the meeting room but it will be possible to follow the meeting in streaming for those who cannot physically access the room: Access to the TCM will be limited to:

- The Jury,
- The Event manager
- The covid referent and Event doctor The Event secretary
- Swiss Timing
- 1 representative per Team
- 1 representative of SRS
- 1 representative of INFRONT













HOW TO REACH THE VENUE FROM THE HOTELS

The race office staff will provide each team with the map with updated directions and the car pass to reach Patascoss, the venue where the parking area reserved for the RED group is located near the "Pancugolo" training track and the Team Hospitality "Rifugio Patascoss"

- Prefer transport with the teams' own vehicles.
- If teams do not have their own transport facilities, shuttles can be provided by the LOC.
- Use the routes indicated on the specific map on the site and follow the directions for parking and dedicated plan located in loc. Patascoss
- Avoid stops between the hotel and the venue.
- Use only the team parking and hospitality area assigned and designated for your team.

EVENT AREA: GENERAL MEASURES

Maintain social distance

- Remain in assigned and marked team zones.
- The team area is delimited and accessible only to accredited persons
- Avoid direct contact with other teams.
- Avoid direct contact with employees / press.
- Mouth and nose protectors must be worn at the venue.

Exceptions:

- o While playing sports.
- o Meals
- o In the start and warm-up area, athletes do not need respiratory IPE, but it is mandatory for all coaches / officials present.
- If a team member feels unwell or exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, contact the LOC immediately at the 3Tre C19 Test and Health Center
- In case of symptoms, an isolation room is reserved closer to the place of the event.











EVENT AREA: SPECIFIC MEASURES

TRAINING

Official training is scheduled on tuesday 21st december at the 5Laghi ski area, "Pancugolo" slope. The "Patascoss chairlift" and the "Pancugolo" training slope will be used exclusively for the event. All people present are registered.

Only the number of people indicated by the appropriate sign can get on the chairlift. Wear respiratory IPE while on the lift.

TEAM HOSPITALITY

Team Hospitality will be host at Rifugio Patascoss that will be reserved by the organization for the event. The entrance is limited only to the team, OC employees or other groups are not allowed.

- Wearing respiratory IPE at the entrance and exit and when leaving the table, ventilation and disinfection each time by the staff
- Sit together exclusively with team colleagues (no contact with other teams).
- Tables will be reserved and may be used only by same team members
- Food will be plated by the staff, no self service

ACCESS TO CHAIRLIFT AND COURSE

Access to the chairlift allowed only to authorized and accredited persons, a preferential access corridor is set up for athletes and team officials.

Access to the track is allowed to a limited number of persons authorized by FIS.

FIS will distribute the course access armbands to the teams at the TCM in a sealed envelope based on the quota provided for by the regulation.

Armbands will be checked before the chairlift access.

STARTING AREA

The entire starting area is an official athlete / team area (red area), fenced off and not accessible for staff and guests.

The LOC staff and the television staff are not authorized to access the warm-up area and are not allowed to circulate in the starting tent during the race. Only the HBC can operate in the starting tent and in the warm-up area. Access control is provided.

Starting house + Tunnel:

Access allowed to only 1 athlete + 2 officials per team. Mask mandatory for officials. Check at the en-













trance to the departure tunnel.

The staff inside the tent must be limited to:

- Start referee
- Swiss Timing starter
- Hand Timing (preferably between the house and the facade, not directly inside)
- Access controller

Staff are required to wear respiratory IPE

Bibs distribution:

Bibs are distributed by the LOC outdoor in the starting area.

Team Tent

Open tent, mask mandatory for everyone

FINISH AREA

Mixed area extension: the area will be extended according to the current distance measures protocol.

Circulatory flow in the mixed zone

The circulatory flow is respectful of the separation of different groups.

- TV/radio/press must maintain social distance from athletes and must wear respiratory IPE during interviews.
- The number of media representatives will be severely restricted in agreement with FIS.

Signs

Appropriate signs will be prepared for the better organization of the circulation flows.











LEAVING MADONNA DI CAMPIGLIO

If, in exceptional cases, someone should have to leave Madonna di Campiglio after arrival day and before departure day, this must be notified immediately in writing to the administration office at: segrete-ria@3trecampiglio.it

We kindly ask to EVERYONE to take their OWN RESPONSIBILITY and to comply and implement all measures and recommendations made!

Guidelines are used to implement or control compliance with the COVID-19 specifications. For your own safety and the safety of other people, you must follow the instructions of the operational staff.

We reserve the right to exclude you from the event and to take legal action in case of non - compliance with the COVID-19 regulations.

The measures were defined in accordance with the current regulations as 10.11.2021

The organizer reserves the right to make necessary changes, which will be announced immediately.
