

**COVID-19: Prevention measures and recommendation for the teams
regarding the “3Tre Audi FIS Ski World Cup – PUBLIC DRAW” event
Piazza Sissi Madonna di Campiglio (TN - Italy) 21.12.2021**

Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, the AUDI FIS Ski World Cup in Madonna di Campiglio (TN – Italy) the 22.12.2021 has to be done under measures of greater safety.

Based on government and sports dispositions , both national and local, as well as disposition adopted by FIS and the Organizing Committee of the event (LOC), with the following we send the current protocol that the teams will have to follow to participate in the PUBLIC DRAW event on the 21.12.2021 in Madonna di Campiglio (TN – Italy) scheduled in Piazza Sissi at 18:30.

It is part of the general **system of prevention/protection of COVID-19 risk** (available on the web site of the event <https://www.3trecampiglio.it/en>) adopted by LOC, in agreement with the local authorities in protection of the health of the workers and the entire community.

We kindly ask to forward this protocol to every subject interested in participating in the Public Draw: members of the teams, athletes, coaches, service personnel, NSA officials, etc.

PROCEDURA PUBLIC DRAW

According to the 9.2 norm of the FIS Alpine World Cup Rules:

The best seven (7) contestants will be drawn from the starting numbers 1 - 7 and the other from 8 - 15. It will be done through double draw.

The draw of the contestants from 8 - 15 will be done electronically, meanwhile the draw of the best 7 athletes will be done publicly at 18:30 on the stage in Piazza Sissi.

The best 7 athletes will be hosted at 18:00 in Hotel St. Hubertus, in a reserved room and dedicated to the red bubble.

Access will be granted to athletes participating in the draw and an escort from their entourage. All will have to be accredited team/athlete belonging to the red bubble.

In shifts, in order of exit, the athletes will be escorted and will reach the stage, walking down the corridor with barriers and distant at least 2 meters from the public present in the plaza.

Before the procedure of the bib assignment, the athletes will be interviewed by our official speaker (duration of the interview 1 question about 1 minute): speaker and athletes will be 1,5 m apart and will speak in a microphone on a shaft.

At the end of the interview the athlete will reach the rack where 7 skis are layed, on each ski tip it is indicated a number (from 1 to 7) covered with an opaque film.

The athlete will indicate the chosen ski that will be taken from the rack by a worker that will take the film off and will show the number to the public.

The athlete will autograph the ski with a marker.

A worker will give the athlete the bib with a corresponding number on a tray.

The athlete will show it to the public for the official photo.

In the end the athlete will receive a personalized bottle of *spumante*, and the athlete will get down the stage and will be escorted back to Hotel St. Hubertus.

All the involved people, athletes, staff, LOC collaborator and speaker will wear DPI devices (chirurgical mask or FFP2) and will stay at a distance of 1,5 meters in reference to the signals that will be indicated on the stage.

All materials (microphones, markers, skis) will be sanitized every time they will be used by different people.

We recommend the athletes to avoid contacts and not stop during the walk from their hotel to Hotel St. Hubertus.

The public in the plaza will be limited to a maximum of 500 people.

The area in front of the stage will have barriers and the access will be allowed only to possessors of Super Green Pass (digital certificate or hard copy that states the complete cycle of vaccination or recovery from Covid-19).

The definite measures will be determined based on the current legislation and the protocol will be updated on the 10.12.2021

The organizer will reserve the right to change what is necessary, and will communicate immediately and publish on the website www.3trecampiglio.it
