

## Media accreditation rules of the 3Tre Madonna di Campiglio AUDI FIS SKI World Cup Night Slalom on December 22nd, 2023 for journalists, photographers, TV and radio operators

- 1. Press journalists and photographers (accredited by newspapers, magazines, photo agencies or professional freelance) can file for accreditation through the on-line application form at <u>www.3trecampiglio.com</u>. All requests must be made not later than December 15th, 2023.
  - 2. Only journalists, photographers and TV/radio operators with a valid professional card can be accredited. Even professionals already in possession of a FIS / AIJS accreditation <u>must</u> follow the procedures for the application of a media accreditation in order to have access to the press facilities and to the event itself.
  - 3. Minimum requirements to get a credential are the fulfillment of the accreditation general terms, the availability of the workspaces in the press room and at the finish area, and the compliance with the FIS and 3Tre Covid-19 regulations and protocols.
  - 4. No freelance media applications will be accepted without a corresponding assignment letter.
  - 5. Each professional is kindly required to collaborate with the LOC by making requests only for the media areas they are actually planning to use, and timely communicating every change of plans, if any.
  - 6. All media will collect their accreditation at the event's Media Center (Sala della Cultura Rainalter Center Via Pradalago, 8). Media must show their request's confirmation at the media room entrance in order to access and collect their accreditation.
  - 7. The Organizing Committee reserves the unappealable right to reject single applications that do not conform with general regulations, the COVID-19 protocol and regulations or requests from non-pertinent media.
  - 8. From December 16th, 2023, applications will be considered only in extraordinary cases, making contact <u>in advance</u> with the Media Team at the <u>3trecampiglio@vitesseonline.it</u>.
  - 9. Infront holds the worldwide TV, radio, Internet and multimedia rights of the 3TRE Madonna di Campiglio AUDI FIS Ski World Cup Night slalom on December 22nd, 2023. Television and radio networks, production and Internet companies are requested to send a dedicated form to Infront Italy as well for the approval of their accreditation. All internet companies shall read and fill in carefully the dedicated form before receiving their personal accreditation at the accreditation office. Both forms are available for download at www.3trecampiglio.com.
  - 10. Course Access for PHOTOGRAPHERS: on-course access is governed by FIS rules and, therefore, the Organizing Committee will be unable to grant any access to photographers not listed by FIS. A dedicated and restricted zone will be reserved to photographers in the finish area, limited to 20 professionals. Photographers applying for a spot on the in-slope platform will be required to express it on the accreditation request. In case of requests exceeding the maximum number, the decision

will be made by the Media Team and the Chief of Photographers according with the FIS guidelines.

Course Access for RADIO/TV: Access to the course is governed by rights-holder Infront Italy in accordance with the FIS Race Director.

Inspection Passes PRESS: Access to the course during inspection is governed by the FIS Race Director. Special cards will be handed out upon request.

- 11. The credential is personal, not transferable and limited to the areas specifically identified on it. Furthermore, the badge shall be always visible, and be shown to all security personnel whenever asked.
- 12. The Press Office has the right to immediately withdraw the accreditation in case of any violation to these regulations and/or to the TV Rights Holder's ones, for their respective areas of competence.
